About the Course:

Intellectual Property Law is well accepted in India due to modernization of industry and more particularly due to Free Trade Policy accepted by India. The concept of Intellectual Property Rights reveals that the importance of IP law is increasing day by day because of Globalization, Free Communication and Transportation which have broken the boundaries of country and therefore, ideas, materials, concepts, products, shapes and other things created by the human mind, known as IP, are easily available and traceable from any corner of the world. Moreover, in educational field, various educational institutions have incorporated Intellectual Property Law as a subject in their syllabus and therefore, preliminary ideas of IP along with its facets are required to be taught to the students of law as well as non-law.

This course will provide the students with basic knowledge of IP Law especially about Patents, Copyrights and Trademarks including the nature and scope of the rights as well as various procedural aspects for obtaining these IPs along with various landmark judgements and recent amendments.

- To provide the students platform to understand the working of Copyright and Trademarks along with practical aspects.

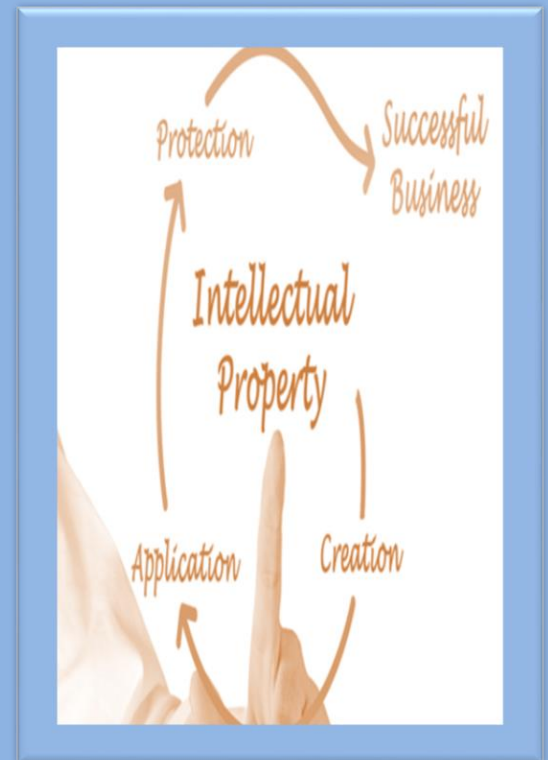
