C. Resolving Tie in Marks:

- Preference for admission will be given to the **Principal Subject** in the T. Y. B. Sc.
- In case of candidates securing equal marks in the Entrance exam, the preference clause, marks secured in the qualifying examination (graduation) will be taken into consideration.

- c. If the tie still persists, then date of birth of the candidate will be considered.
- d. If the tie still persists, the alphabetical ordering of the first name of the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- e. As per government of Maharashtra directive, NTC, NTD and OBC category candidates should submit non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019 from a competent authority. Otherwise they shall not be eligible for admission from the respective category.
- f. A candidate belonging to SBC is eligible to claim admission according to his/her old caste. In that case, he/she must follow all the rules applicable for that category (e.g. if his/her old caste falls under OBC/NTC/NTD, he/she has to submit the non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019).
- g. 3% seats are reserved for Physically Challenged students.
- h. 5% seats are reserved for wards of ex/active defence servicemen.
- i. The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.
- j. Note that the admissions granted as per the above schedule will be confirmed on verifying the results of qualifying degree examination and original documents.

Admissions Schedule for the M. Sc. Part I Chemistry Courses

1. Schedule –Table Admission First Round:

- Date: 10 July 2019
- Venue: Amphi Theatre
- Reporting Time: 10.00 a.m.
- SPPU Students: Merit Nos. : 01 to 300
- Reserve Category SPPU : All students
- Other Than SPPU Students: Merit Nos. 01 to 100
- Reserve Category Other Than SPPU : All students

2. If the student is late by any reason more than 10 minutes, then he/she will not be allowed to attend the session and will not have any claim on any seat.

3. There will be parallel admission for Defence and Physically Challenged students.

4. The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.

5. Notice for vacant seats (if any) will be displayed on the college website.

Students from Reserved Categories must have Original Caste Certificate, Caste Validation Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Status Certificate (for those categories where it is required) at time of admission. In the absence of these documents, the candidate will be processed under general category only. No request for concessions for submission at a later date will be entertained.
