M.Sc. (Data Science)

1. The admissions to M.Sc. (DS) will be based on Entrance Examination, which was conducted on 30th June 2019.
2. Admissions to M.Sc. (DS) are based on the score in the entrance examination only.
3. Admissions to the courses will be given as per the schedule given below, on 9th July 2019.
4. The total intake capacity of M.Sc. (DS) is 30 seats.
5. Following is the distribution of the seats:

a) Students of Savitribai Phule Pune University:

- Resolving tie in marks -
 - a) In case of candidates securing equal marks in the Entrance exam, the marks secured in the qualifying examination (graduation) will be taken into consideration.
 - b) If the tie still persists, then date of birth of the candidate will be considered.
 - c) If the tie still persists, the alphabetical ordering of the name of the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- As per government of Maharashtra directive, NTC, NTD and OBC category candidates should submit non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019 from a competent authority. Otherwise they shall not be eligible for admission from the respective category.

- A candidate belonging to SBC is eligible to claim admission according to his/her old caste. In that case, he/she must follow all the rules applicable for that category (e.g. if his/her old caste falls under OBC/NTC/NTD, he/she has to submit the non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019).
- 3 % seats are reserved for Physically Challenged students.
- 5% seats are reserved for wards of ex/active servicemen.
- The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.
- Note that the admissions granted as per the above schedule will be confirmed on verifying the results of qualifying degree.

Fees for Admissions to M.Sc. (DS):

- Maharashtra student Rs. 109810 per year
- Outside Maharashtra student Rs. 200310 per year

Schedule for Admissions to M.Sc. (DS)

1. The student should be present in classroom C6 as per the schedule given below for admission to M.Sc. (DS) course.
2. **If the student is late by more than 10 minutes, then he/she will not be allowed to attend the session and will not have any claim on any seat for that round.**
3. The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.
4. The students should report 15 mins before the counselling round.

Admission Schedule for Students Registered for M.Sc. (DS)

Tuesday, 9th July 2019

- 10.00 a.m.:** All physically challenged students from Savitribai Phule Pune University eligible for M.Sc. (DS) .
 AND
 Wards of Ex/Active serviceman from Savitribai Phule Pune University eligible for M.Sc. (DS).
 AND
 Students from Savitribai Phule Pune University in General category merit list of M.Sc. (DS) from serial number 1 to 25 (till seats are available) for admission to M.Sc. (DS) course.

- 11.00 a.m.:** All students from Savitribai Phule Pune University belonging to SC, ST, NT (B, C, D), DT (A) category who are eligible for M.Sc. (DS) course.
- 11.30 a.m.:** All students from Savitribai Phule Pune University belonging to SEBC (with serial number 1 to 10) and EWS category eligible for admission to M.Sc. (DS) course.
- 12.00 p.m.:** All students from Savitribai Phule Pune University belonging to OBC (with serial number 1 to 15) eligible for admission to M.Sc. (DS) course.
- 12.30 p.m.:** All students from **Other University** belonging to SC, SEBC and from general seat list (serial number 1 to 10) eligible for admission to M.Sc. (DS) course.

Students from Reserved Categories must have Original Caste Certificate, Caste Validation Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Status Certificate (for those categories where it is required) at time of admission. In the absence of these documents, the candidate will be processed under general category only. No request for concessions for submission at a later date will be entertained.
