M.Sc. I (Microbiology) – Admissions 2019-20

Notice for First Round

1. The admissions to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) will be based on Entrance Examination, which was conducted on 7th June 2019.
2. Admissions to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) will be based on the score in the entrance examination only.
3. Admissions to the course will be given as per the schedule given below, on 10th July 2019.
4. The total intake capacity of M.Sc. I (Microbiology) is 24 seats.
5. The Fees for the M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course will be:
 - Domicile Maharashtra Students: 63,060/-
 - Non-Maharashtra Students: 1,04,250 /-
6. Following is the distribution of the seats :
 - a) Students of Savitribai Phule Pune University:

- b) Students from Other University (other than Savitribai Phule Pune University):

- Resolving tie in marks -
 - a) In case of candidates securing equal marks in the Entrance exam, the preference criterion will be marks secured in the qualifying examination (graduation): grand (S.Y.B.Sc. and T.Y.B.Sc.) total followed by principal

subject marks will be taken into consideration.

- b) If the tie still persists, then date of birth of the candidate will be considered.
- c) If the tie still persists, the alphabetical ordering of the name of the candidate will be taken into consideration.

- As per government of Maharashtra directive, NTC, NTD and OBC category candidates should submit non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019 from a competent authority. Otherwise they shall not be eligible for admission from the respective category.
- A candidate belonging to SBC is eligible to claim admission according to his/her old caste. In that case, he/she must follow all the rules applicable for that category (e.g. if his/her old caste falls under OBC/NTC/NTD, he/she has to submit the non-creamy layer certificate issued after 31st March 2019).
- 3% seats are reserved for Physically Challenged students.
- 5% seats are reserved for wards of ex/active servicemen.
- The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.
- Note that the admissions granted as per the above schedule will be confirmed on verifying the results of qualifying degree.

Schedule for Admissions to M.Sc. I (Microbiology)

1. The student should be present in classroom C6 as per the schedule given below for admission to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course.
- 2. If the student is late by more than 10 minutes then he/she will not be allowed to attend the session and will not have any claim on any seat.**
3. The process will stop as and when all available seats are full.
4. The students should report 15 minutes before the counseling round.

11.00 a.m.	All physically challenged students from Savitribai Phule Pune University eligible for M.Sc. I (Microbiology) AND Wards of Ex/Active serviceman/ Army from Savitribai Phule Pune University eligible for M.Sc. I (Microbiology)
11.15 a.m.	Students from Savitribai Phule Pune University in General category merit list of M.Sc. I (Microbiology) (till seats are available) for admission to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course.
11.45 a.m.	All students from Savitribai Phule Pune University belonging to SC, ST, NT (B,C, D), DT(A), SEBC and EWS category eligible for admission to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course (till seats are available).
12.30 p.m.	Students from Savitribai Phule Pune University belonging to OBC Category eligible for admission to M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course (till seats are available).
1.00 p.m.	Students from Other Universities belonging to GENERAL category AND All students from SC category with domicile state 'Maharashtra', who is eligible for M.Sc. I (Microbiology) course.

Students from Reserved Categories must have Original Caste Certificate, Caste Validation Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Status Certificate (for those categories where it is required) at the time of admission. In the absence of these documents, the candidate's application will be processed under general category only. No request for concessions for submission at a later date will be entertained.
